From the Principal

Dear Parents

Canteen

As mentioned in our letter sent to parents, we were notified by Munch Canteen late on Tuesday 6 June that the canteen services provided by them would finish at the end of business Wednesday 7 June. This information did come as a shock to us as we were not aware that they were going to close their business.

We had been made aware that they were not going to renew their contract with us, as well as a number of schools, at the end of this term. The school was in the process of appointing another Canteen operator to start at the beginning of Term 3.

Mel's Tasty Bites (www.melstastybites.com) has now been appointed as the new Canteen operator. They will commence on Monday 19 June. We want the new Canteen provider to be able to use our new canteen premises, therefore the builder will have a week to install all the equipment, carpentry and new oven. All hot and cold food will be made fresh on the premises. The Menu will be sent home prior to their commencement.

We are very appreciative of our new operator being able to assist us by setting up earlier than they were expecting and their efforts to work around the clock to have a canteen ready for our families on Monday 19 June.

We look forward to working with them and thank you in advance for your support of Mel and her team as they transition into our St Michael's community.

Refurbished building update

The refurbished building which will house all of Year 2, the Library, Music room, Learning support, Canteen and Kids Club is being handed over to us in part on Friday. We will be moving into the Year 2 spaces, the Library, Music Room and Learning support space. The new Canteen will be opened on Monday 19 June.

During the coming holidays there will be a lot of work happening with the cementing of the road way into the school, the demolition of one kindergarten classroom and the old Canteen, new awning and gardens, and the renovation of three classrooms for OOSH.

We hope that the builders will have completed all the work by the end of July.

OOSH—During the holidays OOSH will be using our Kids Club space in the refurbished building. When we return after the holidays, OOSH will continue to use the school hall until their new spaces have been completed.

Reflection

This Sunday we celebrate Trinity Sunday—the three Persons of God: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The most common prayer of the Trinity is “The sign of the cross”. The purpose of the feast day should be one of reassurance and optimism.

The **Father** is associated with the positive and ongoing act of creation. The Father challenges us to be positive and creative with our lives; to be creative in our relationship with our partner, children, friends, neighbours; not be destructive or negative but to come up with more praise than criticism.

The **Son** is associated with being a peacemaker: “I have come to bring Peace not conflict”. After his resurrection, his first words in each of his appearances were, “Peace be with you”. Peacemakers are strong in virtues. Jesus expressed loyalty when he stuck by Peter who three times denied him—Peter later became the first Pope. Do we stick by our family, including our extended family, in their troubles? Are we ever ready to show compassion, gentleness, kindness, forgiveness—to give positive vibes into the lives of our people?

The **Spirit** is associated with gifting. The Apostles illustrated the potential that the Spirit has for positive responses in our lives. On the first Pentecost they were “filled with the Spirit” and began their remarkable careers of preaching Christ throughout the world. We, likewise, are gifted by the spirit at Baptism and Confirmation. How has the “career” of our life progressed? Is it reflective of love, care and forgiveness?

John, who was present at the first Pentecost, wrote in his Gospel, “I will ask the Father and he will give you another Helper who will stay with you forever. He is the Spirit who reveals the truth about God.” *John 4.6* Jesus is telling his disciples that there is nothing to fear, even if he is about to leave them. He, the Father and the Spirit will continue to protect them. He does not guarantee that there will not be difficulties to work through, but he does promise that there will be eternal life.

We are called to live in harmony and peace; we are encouraged to support one another, to love one another. God so desired a relationship with us that God sent Jesus. We need to respond to this relationship. We need to love back and we do this by our relationships with one another. We need to put energy into our loving. Trinity is a reminder of God's love and a challenge for us to be pro-active with our love.

“Dear Lord, Help us to be positive in our thoughts and deeds so that we can help and support each other every day. Help us to use our gifts of compassion, gentleness, kindness and forgiveness in all our experiences. Help us to take the time to reflect, be present in the moments that fill our day and act always with wisdom and love. Amen”

It provides parents with the most convenient way to receive school notifications and is a free service to families.

The Skoolbag App is used when there are sporting events such as training or gala days that may be postponed due to bad weather at the last minute.

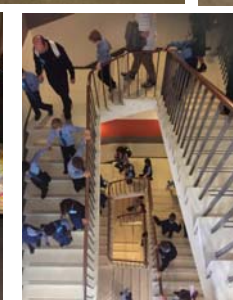

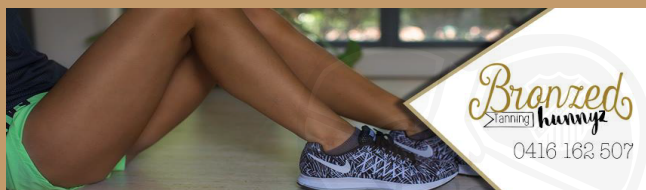

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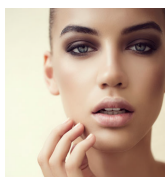
