Reflection

Our life is a gift that comes to us through a graciousness that is beyond our understanding. Every adult and every child has a talent and an ability to contribute to the good of the broader life around them. But are we daring enough to "stick our neck out" or "go out on that limb" to realise the potential of our ability?

We can "if" and "but" about life too much and before we know it, life has passed us by. As someone once put it, "Too often opportunity knocks but by the time we push back the bolt, undo the two locks, take off the three chains and turn off the alarm, it's too late." When attempting something new or different, we must not be afraid to make mistakes. If we want to achieve something, we have to be prepared to take the knocks and experience failure. Life is a little like playing chess; as some of the chessmen move forward they may be beaten, but they may set up a winning game.

Recent research from Standford University has found that your outlook on learning matters just as much as IQ. Scientists and educators have long noted that children who have a positive attitude towards Maths do better in the subject. Brain scans of the children in this study found that a brain area linked with memory and learning was more active in children with a positive attitude towards Maths. A good attitude opens the door to high achievement which means a good circle of learning.

It may remain largely impossible to change your child's natural intellectual gifts but it is entirely "do-able" to help them foster more positive attitudes towards a given subject and their own potential.

"Ever-present and surprising God, Your Son has shown us that you are at home among the human family.

Grace us to build communities of loving stones marked by loving compassion for one another, especially the most vulnerable and those with whom Jesus sat at the table.

For we are a Eucharistic people who gather at tables of welcome, where Christ is our host and our nourishment. We ask this in his name. Amen"



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

Parking Rules & Penalties

Council's Compliance Officers enforce parking signs at your school.

When it comes to the safety of vulnerable road users like school children, drivers found breaking the law will be met with zero tolerance. When an offence is detected, you will be fined.



NO STOPPING

You must not STOP at any time.

Stopping includes when the vehicle is not moving but the engine is still running.

SCHOOL ZONE



NO PARKING

You can stop only to drop off or pick

up passengers or goods and you must not stop for more than 2 minutes and The driver must stay within 3 metres of your vehicle. Stopping includes when the vehicle is not moving but the engine is still running.

SCHOOL ZONE



You must not stop your vehicle in a Bus Zone unless you are driving a public bus.

Stopping includes when the vehicle is not moving but the engine is still running.

SCHOOL ZONE



DRIVEWAYS

You must not park your car over or block access to a driveway. You can stop in a driveway to drop off or pick up passengers BUT only for less than 2 minutes AND the driver must stay with the car.

You have no more than 2 minutes for drop-offs or pick-ups and must stay within 3 metres of your vehicle.




