# School Pedestrian Crossing Chapel Lane



 Information was recently received regarding a mother stopping her car on the pedestrian crossing on Chapel Lane, getting out of the car and then getting her child out of the car. Another parent then walked across from the side of the road and escorted the child to the side of the road. The mother then got in her car and drove away leaving traffic banked up in both directions.

This type of activity is extremely dangerous and highly likely to cause an accident. We would ask all our parents/ carers, to please follow safe road practices and instil safe road practices in your children. Children are always watching and model what they see.

 Last year we applied for a school crossing supervisor but we were unsuccessful due to not enough student/car movements over the crossing.

We have just received a letter from the Minister for Roads, Maritime and Freight to advise that the NSW Liberals & Nationals Government is going to add a further 300 school crossing supervisors during 2019-2020.

St Michael's will be one of the 69 schools chosen to become eligible for a school crossing supervisor. We look forward to receiving a school crossing supervisor this year.
