#### School Swimming Program Years 1, 2 & 3

St Michael's is able to participate in our annual Swimming Program for Years 1, 2 and 3, and will take place in Week 9, **Monday 7 December to Friday 11 December**. The program will be held at Castle Hill Fitness & Aquatic Centre, Castle Hill RSL. Castle Hill Fitness and Aquatic Centre and St Michael's have COVID safety plans in place.

On the first day of swimming your child will be grouped according to the information you've supplied on the Grading Form that was sent home last week. Children will then be assessed and regrouped accordingly.

All children must attend the Swimming Program. Due to COVID restrictions parents are unable to attend the centre.

Please return the Grading Form to your child's teacher no later than Friday 6 November.

The children in Years 1, 2 & 3 are to wear their sport or summer uniform during the program.

The children will need to bring a plastic bag or swimming bag containing the following items:

- Swimming costume
- Towel
- t-shirt or long sleeved top (to wear to and from the pool on the bus)
- Thongs or sandals (to wear to and from the pool)
- Goggles
- Dry underwear
- Swimming caps will be provided by the centre

#### Volunteering at St Michael's

In order to become a school volunteer at St Michael's Primary school, including Stop & Drop, all volunteers must complete a <u>BCSC Undertaking Form and Training Module for Volunteers and Contractors.</u>

The purpose of this module is to inform you of the standards of behaviour and other requirements that must be adhered to when delivering services to children and students.

The undertaking should take no more than 5 minutes to complete and the training module approximately 15 minutes.

Once the form and training modules are submitted an automated email will be sent to you within 24 hours to confirm the status of your submission.

The undertaking form will expire within 2 years or when you WWCC expires (if applicable) whichever is sooner. At this time you will need to complete the Undertaking form and training module again. You will receive an automatic reminder email when this occurs.

Start your training to become a volunteer:

1. Go St Michael's website - http://www.stmichaelsbhills.catholic.edu.au

2. Click on Enrol Now, go to Parent Involvement, click on Child Protection Course. You will then be directed to the Catholic Education Office – Diocese of Parramatta website, Scroll down and click on "Start Now", then click on "Begin Undertaking".

3. You will be given a "BSCS" number. Please email your name and the BSCS number to the school at <a href="mailto:stmichaelsbhills@parra.catholic.edu.au">stmichaelsbhills@parra.catholic.edu.au</a>

All Parent volunteers must complete the Child protection training module and Undertaking for Volunteers form online before they can assist in the school.
