From the Principal

Dear Parents

Mother's Day 10 May

Thank you to the P&F Committee for their generous support in celebrating Mother's Day by setting up the online purchase of gifts and making themselves available last Saturday for the gifts to be collected by our families. Their support is very much appreciated and I am sure this will help to make the celebration of Mother's Day so much more enjoyable for our mothers.

Weeks 3 and 4

As mentioned in our communication to you on 1 May, our children will begin a phased return to onsite learning in Weeks 3 and 4 based on their sport colour house. The children will attend for one day each week in sport colour houses:

Monday - Blue (Mercedes); Tuesday - Red (Clare); Wednesday - Green (Quinn); Thursday - Gold (McAuley)

The decision about the attendance of your child remains your choice as parents and we fully appreciate that there will be students whose circumstance mean that they will not be able to return to school in the foreseeable future and other children who will need to return up to five days each week. Our staff are very mindful of this as they continue to prepare for the staged return to school over the coming weeks. Online learning will continue for the children who do not return to school. Information regarding student attendance in Weeks 5 and 6 will be sent out next week.

Hygiene

With the percentage of students returning to school increasing at a daily rate, please remind your children of the importance of maintaining strict hygiene. The washing of hands and making sure that if they are sneezing that they sneeze into their elbows and any used tissues are then discarded into the bin. Children who are unwell should remain at home.

Uniform

Traditionally we return to school in our full winter uniform on the first Monday after Mother's Day. Families who have not yet purchased a winter uniform are encouraged to do so. Children will be expected to have their full winter uniform by the end of May.

Social distancing

Please note that we need to continue practising social distancing in the school and for our parents this means that only one adult or one adult with children can be in the school foyer for a limited amount of time.

Once the children transition to three or more days a week, it will be difficult to practice social distancing and therefore we require as many families as possible to use the Slow & Go system in the afternoon to collect their children.

Morning Stop & Drop is not in operation at the moment. Please ensure that when you are using the Parish car park that you are very mindful of the maximum speed limit of 10 km/ph and the presence of pedestrians.

Mother's Day Reflection

Enrolment Process

Enrolment at St Michael's Primary Catholic Primary School includes your return of the Enrolment Application with the following documents

- Birth Certificate copy and original for viewing
- Baptism Certificate copy and original for viewing
- Immunisation History Statement (visit www.medicareaustralia.gov.au or call 1800 653 809 and request your statement)
- Passport with visa (if not Australian Citizens).

It is essential that both parents/guardians sign the different sections of the Enrolment Application. Your prompt return of this form will be appreciated.

New Families will be contacted for an interview time in Term 3 or 4.

Existing families with Kindergarten 2021 children will be offered a place once on their Enrolment applications and supporting documents have been received and finalised.

For those children who have a diagnosis of learning difficulties, autism, or being on the spectrum, we ask that you provide the school with the appropriate report from the specialist or other practitioner. In that way we can ensure that the appropriate resources and support are in place for entry into school. We will contact you with regard to meeting you and your child to support their needs prior to them starting in 2021.

Social Skill Tips for Parents

Week 1: Mantra 3 - Dobbing versus Telling

- Are you dobbing or telling?
- Dobbing', is when you are trying to get someone into trouble.
- 'Telling', is when you are getting your EARLY WARNING SIGNS'. You feel unsafe, so you must tell some you trust who will listen to you. At school this is a teacher.

Week 2: The Circle concept

 The 'Circle concept' teaches a child about personal space and appropriate behaviour with others, depending on what their relationship is to the child.

Week 3: Sign language: Thumbs up, thumbs down

- We all have the right to feel safe all the time.
- Sign language:- Thumbs up: I feel safe.
- Thumbs down: I don't feel safe.
- This can be used in the classroom, playground and at home.




Practice simple hygiene by washing hands regularly
